PUBLIC HEARING SEWER RATE INCREASE APRIL 9, 2024 6:45 PM

Present: Deputy Mayor Stabb, Trustees Brach, Andrews and Satterly, Treasurer Kaiding, and Clerk Lee.

Absent: Mayor Dellerba.

Deputy Mayor Stabb called the Public Hearing to order at 6:45 pm.

Deputy Mayor Stabb presented the proposed rate increase of 3.1% to the sewer rates. The following current and proposed rates are as follows:

2023 Current Sewer Rates:

\$51.30 (quarterly flat rate for 5,000 gallons or less – charged to all users)

\$5.25 – assessed for each 1,000 gallons used over the initial 5,000 gallons – Village users

\$5.75 – assessed for each 1,000 gallons used over the initial 5,000 gallons – Outside users

2024 Proposed Sewer Rate Increase of 3.1%:

\$52.55 (quarterly flat rate for 5,000 gallons or less – charged to all users)

\$5.45 – assessed for each 1,000 gallons used over the initial 5,000 gallons – Village users

\$5.95 – assessed for each 1,000 gallons used over the initial 5,000 gallons – Outside users

There are several costly upgrades that will need to be made to the Wastewater Treatment Plant per NYS DEC guidelines.
