PUBLIC INFORMATION

Please be advised that the Village of Boonville DPW will be picking up curbside lawn clippings and green waste.

Pick up from April 17 until November 13 on Mondays only with a Special pick up the 2nd Tuesday in January for holiday green waste
Green waste must be at the curb side of the street for no longer than 24 hrs.

Stored green waste for pick up must meet the property maintenance code of the Village of Boonville and the 2023 Building codes of New York State.

Contractors are prohibited from placing green waste and brush at the curb; they are responsible for their own disposal.

Acceptable green waste to leave for curbside pickup are lawn clippings, leaves, and branches up to 4" in diameter and 4' in length. There will be no shrub/root ball pickup at the curb and container used shall weighing no more than 50 pounds.

Absolutely no pet waste, garbage, lumber, or any other refuse items. If your curbside debris is found to have any of the waste items in it that are not permissible, the debris will not be picked up.

Boonville residents can also bring their green waste, brush, limbs larger than 4" inches in diameter and longer than 4' in length and shrubs/root balls over 50 pounds to the Boonville Transfer Site at, 13680 State Route 12., between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday except Holidays.
